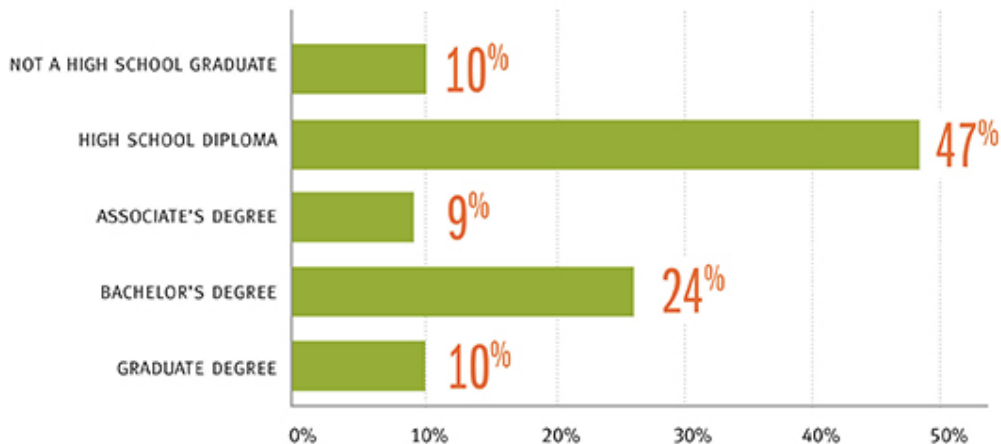

Educational Attainment for 25 to 34 Year Olds



Educational Attainment is on the Rise

Earning a bachelor's degree is becoming more common among Americans between the ages of 25 and 34.

In 2015, 34% of adults between the ages of 25 to 34 had earned at least a bachelor's degree. This is an improvement over the 2008 rate, when just 29% of adults ages 25 to 34 had hit the bachelor degree benchmark.

One in Five Kids Speak A Language Other Than English at Home

Twenty-two percent of children in America — nearly 12 million kids total — speak a language other than English at home, according to the [KIDS COUNT Data Center](#).

The prevalence of bilingual children varies widely by state, with higher concentrations of bilingual children living in the Southwest. Rates range from a low of 2% in West Virginia to a high of 45% in California.
